Tuition/Fees

All tuition and fees are due to the Business Office no later than May 1, 2019 (cash or money order only). Any student who has not paid their tuition and fees will not be eligible to attend the Prom or other graduation activities. Senior Exams

The Senior 4th Quarter Exams are scheduled for **the week of May 20th** and the exam schedule will be posted in school and on the school website when available. Consult Ms. Moseley in the Guidance Office (x108) with any questions. If a senior is absent for an exam, that exam must be made up before participating in any graduation exercises. An **exemption** is only given to seniors who have **achieved 93 or above** in all quarters.

The entire Graduation program at Benedictine Academy includes *The Baccalaureate Mass*, *Graduation/Baccalaureate Mass Practices*, and the *Graduation Ceremony*. ***It is mandatory that all seniors attend all of the above programs. It is imperative that the seniors are on time for all graduation programs including the practices.*** We are guests of Holy Spirit Church and the parish may have scheduled events after our practices.

The Baccalaureate Mass will be held at St. Walburga Monastery. Seating is limited to four 3 people per family. After the Baccalaureate Mass, the Alumnae Association of Benedictine Academy will host refreshments in the St. Walburga Spirituality Center for the seniors and their families. Seniors are to meet in the foyer or reception area of the Monastery by 7:00 pm.

The seniors are to report to Holy Spirit Church on the afternoon of graduation no later than 12:00 pm. **PLEASE NOTE THAT BALLOONS ARE NOT PERMITTED INSIDE THE CHURCH.** The Graduation program will include the induction to the Alumnae Association of Benedictine Academy.

PLEASE NOTE: Graduates will receive a diploma cover at the graduation ceremony. ***The actual diploma (which fits inside the diploma cover) can be picked up at Benedictine Academy on Monday, June 10 or Tuesday, June 11 from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm.***

Dress for the Baccalaureate Mass

Dress for the Baccalaureate Mass is the same as graduation except the graduates will not wear their graduation cap. Graduation gowns will be distributed after practice on Wednesday, June 5 Therefore it is imperative that all graduates attend the practice on Thursday, June 6, 2019 to receive their caps and gowns for the Baccalaureate Mass and graduation. Please do not try to pick these items up during the school day.

Dress for Graduation

Graduates are to wear appropriate light-colored shoes or sandals with backing (no flip-flops). Pants may not be worn. Dresses must be white or a pastel color so as to not show through the gown.

Tickets

Tickets for the Baccalaureate Mass: Tickets are limited to **three (3)** per family, due to the limited size of the Monastery Church.

Tickets for Graduation: Tickets are limited to **ten (10)** per family. Two (2) tickets are designated as “Reserved Seating.” Eight (8) “Admit One” tickets are designated for your other guests. Other guest seating will be available on a first-come basis.

Tickets and Invitations will not be distributed until all tuition and fees have been paid!

From the Garden State Parkway Northbound:

- Take exit **#140/HOLLAND TUNNEL (RT-82 E)** onto **US-22 E**
- Take ramp onto **MORRIS AVE(RT-82)** toward **ELIZABETH**
- Go .6 miles and turn right onto **SUBURBAN RD**
- Church is on right.

From the Garden State Parkway Southbound:

- Take exit **#140A/ELIZABETH (RT-82 E)/SOMERVILLE** onto **US-22 W**
 - Take ramp toward **ELIZABETH (RT-82 E)/US-22**
 - Turn right on **INGERSOLL TER**
 - Turn right on **MORRIS AVE(RT-82)** and proceed .7 miles
 - Turn right on **SUBURBAN RD**
